NURSE AIDE I REFRESHER

This 48-hour class will prepare the student for Credentia state testing to become a Certified Nursing Aide I. All students who attend this class must have completed a state approved Nurse Aide I course and have been active on a Nurse Aide Registry.

Please note that this class is not a substitute for the Nurse Aide I Course.

This class will demonstrate and allow the student to practice all 46 Credentia skills. Theory/lecture will accompany the skills during class sessions.

Students at the completion of this class will be prepared to register for the exam and skills evaluation testing examination.

To Register Must Provide

- Current Driver's License, State Issued Identification Card, or Passport
- · Social Security Card must be signed and not laminated
- Names must match on ALL documents
- Proof of Nurse Aide I course completion from any state in USA (status on NA-1 Registry-current or expired)
