Basic Law Enforcement Training Student Learning Outcomes:

SLO #1:

Students will demonstrate their understanding of the Legal Unit through a combination of topic related tests (requiring a minimum 80% success rate) as measured by course grades on the Legal Unit, and 70% on the state exam.

SLO #2:

Students will demonstrate their understanding of the Patrol Duties Unit through a combination of topic related tests requiring a minimum 80% success rate.

SLO #3:

Students will demonstrate their understanding of the Law Enforcement Communications Unit through a combination of topic related tests requiring a minimum 80% success rate.

SLO #4:

Students will demonstrate their understanding of the Investigation Unit through a combination of topic related tests (requiring a minimum 80% success rate) as measured by course grades on the Investigation Unit, and 70% on the state exam.

SLO #5:

Students will demonstrate their understanding of the Practical Application Unit through a combination of topic related tests requiring a minimum 80% success rate.

SLO #6:

Students will demonstrate their knowledge of the Sheriff's Unit through a combination of topic related tests (requiring a minimum score of 80% success rate) as measured by course grades on the Sheriff's Unit, and 70% on the State exam.
